SUMMER 2007 UNLV FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION

Law students interested in receiving financial aid for summer course work must use this application. Summer aid applicants must have a completed 2006/2007 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by the June 30, 2007 application deadline. Also required is the attached **2007 UNLV SUMMER Financial Aid Application** form.

The summer 2007 semester is part of the 2006/2007 academic year. The amount of loan eligibility for the summer 2007 semester will be based upon your summer cost of attendance, and the unused portion of your 2006/2007 annual loan maximums. The U.S. Department of Education sets the annual federal student loan program maximums for professional students at \$8,500 subsidized and \$10,000 unsubsidized loan, or \$18,500 total. If you have borrowed less than \$18,500 in the federal loan programs in 2006/2007, you will be offered the remainder **up to the limit of your eligibility** for the summer semester.

Alternative loan funds are available from private lenders to qualifying students who need additional funds. If you need financial assistance in addition to your remaining federal loans, please check the Student Financial Services web site for a list of preferred lenders. You can apply for most of these loans online. The amount of a private alternative loan is determined by your estimated cost of attendance, minus all other financial assistance awarded to you for the term.

You are responsible for fee payment by the LAW SCHOOL deadlines for each summer session. Check the law school summer Registration Schedule for further details.

Once you have completed the aid application process and registered for all the law courses and *approved* non-law courses listed on the summer aid application, **summer financial aid will disburse directly to your university account approximately 1 week prior to your first scheduled class.** All law student applicants must enroll in at least four credit hours for SUMMER financial aid eligibility. Prior approval from Dean for Student Advancement Frank Durand is required for enrollment in *non-law* courses. Changes in your intended enrollment, number of credit hours or dates of enrollment, must be reported to Student Financial Services by completing a SUMMER ENROLLMENT REVISION REQUEST form at Student Financial Services. **Your enrollment level must match the information used in calculating your aid or payment will be delayed.**
