

JUSTICE MICHAEL L. DOUGLAS

- **Appointed by Governor Kenny Guinn to the Supreme Court of Nevada in April 2004. Elected in November 2004; re-elected in November 2006 to a full six-year term effective January 2007.**
- **Appointed by Governor Miller to the Eighth Judicial District Court in November 1995. Elected in November of 1996 to a six-year term effective January 1997; re-elected in November 2002 to a second six-year term effective January 2003.**
- **Elected Chief Judge of the Eighth Judicial District Court in October 2003; Assistant Chief Judge in 2003; and Presiding Civil Judge 2001-2002.**
- **Graduated from the University of California Hastings College of the Law in 1974; B.A. from California State College, Long Beach in 1971; The National Judicial College Reno, General Jurisdiction Program in 1996.**
- **Practiced law in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.**
- **Moved to Las Vegas in 1982, as a Staff Attorney for Nevada Legal Services, later became Managing Attorney.**

- **Joined the Clark County District Attorney's Office in 1984 and worked in the Family Support Division.**
- **In 1985 Justice Douglas moved to the Civil Division of the District Attorney's Office where he practiced administrative law, contract and legislative review and litigation, along with agency advisement. He also represented the Clark County Liquor and Gaming Licensing Board.**
- **Justice Douglas serves on Nevada Supreme Court Committees (Access to Justice, Emergency Management, Specialty Court Funding, Statewide Court Security, Bench Bar, and Bar Exam Study).**
- **Justice Douglas is a member of the American Bar Association, State Bar of Nevada, Clark County Bar Association, National Bar Association – Las Vegas Chapter, Pennsylvania Bar Association, Nevada American Inns of Court, Hastings College of the Law, California State University, Long Beach; Alumni Association, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, and Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity.**
- **Justice Douglas is a former member of the State Bar of Nevada Disciplinary Board, Professionalism Committee, Access to Justice Committee, the Eighth Judicial District Pro Bono Foundation, the Nevada District Judges Association, and the Nevada Gaming Attorneys.**
- **Justice Douglas is active in many community projects and activities.**
