<b>Topic</b>	<b>About the Session</b>
Opening Remarks	
The Debate Over Legal Gambling	Legalized gambling has expanded dramatically over the last several decades. This session will discuss some of the key social and economic impacts of the legalization of gaming in communities.
Gambling Policies and Goals	This session explores how the debate over casino legalization and subsequent regulation of casinos can best focus on a reasoned consideration of costs and benefits and a clear articulation of a state's public policy goals.
Policy Implementation	In this session, the speakers will discuss risk control and how jurisdictions can best implement broader public policy goals as part of their regulatory practice.
Keynote Introduction <b>Lunch Keynote Speaker</b>	Bo Bernhard <b>Chairman A.G. Burnett</b>
Structuring a Casino Industry	This session emphasizes the importance of establishing the structure of the casino industry prior to the enactment of gaming law and identifies a few key public policy and regulatory issues that a jurisdiction should consider.
Economic Impacts of Regulation	The gambling industry and its regulators face significant challenges identifying and measuring the right policies, outcomes, and procedures. This session will analyze the economics of gambling regulation to better understand the advantages and limitations of this approach.
Regulatory Agency Organization	This session explains the discrete organizational components of an effective and comprehensive regulatory regime.

<b>Thursday, Sept 4</b>	
<b>Topic</b>	<b>About the Session</b>
Understanding the Politics of Gaming Regulation and How to Protect the Process	This session will explore some of the ethical challenges in gaming regulation and operation. It will also explore some of the policy and regulatory challenges faced by Indian tribes engaged in gaming.
Panel: Meeting Compliance in a Worldwide Environment	How do we create and maintain a compliant gaming environment? What is each person's role? This session will provide perspectives from both the operator and regulator points of view.
Anti Money Laundering-East vs. West Comparison	This session will examine money laundering from an American and an Asian regulatory perspective. What are criminals doing? What can casinos do to prevent criminal activity? What do governments require casinos to do to comply with anti-money laundering requirements?
Keynote Introduction <b>Lunch Keynote Speaker</b>	David Schwartz <b>Jan Jones Blackhurst</b>
Addressing Problem Gambling	This session explores responsible gambling as a player protection mechanism, addressing both prevention and harm minimization.
Controlling Electronic/Computer Games and Equipment	In this session, we will explore the increasingly sophisticated methods utilized by gaming regulatory agencies and gaming operators to regulate and manage gaming technology innovation.
Panel: Has Technology Stripped Our Ability to Regulate the Gaming Industry?	This panel examines the impact of technology on the casino industry and the subsequent challenges face by regulators.

<b>Friday, Sept. 5</b>	
<b>Topic</b>	<b>About the Session</b>
Auditing and Accounting of Casino Revenues	Accounting and audit requirements are key components of a comprehensive gaming law, and developing effective audit and accounting requirements begins with an understanding of the relevant public policies.
Panel: Taxation	This panel will examine taxation issues from several points of view including identifying a jurisdiction's taxation goals and the effects of taxation regimes on individual gamblers. What is a fair taxation policy?
Panel: Advantage Play, Crimes and Enforcement-What is Cheating? How do We Handle Advantage Play?	This panel will explore the tension between casinos and individual gamblers over which gambling activities are a legitimate reflection of higher skill and experience, and which gambling activities should be banned or criminalized.
Catching the Bad Guys	A look at catching the bad guys from a veteran regulator. What are some current trends? What should you look for?
Licensing of Industry Participants	In this session, the speakers will explore the licensing process and best practices to provide a framework for governments to craft and implement a licensing program.
Investigations of Industry Participants	What does it take to get a gaming licensing? What are the qualifications? Are the requirements standard across jurisdictions? This session will examine the details of the investigatory process.
Exclusions	This session will examine recent trends in the practice of casinos preventing some patrons from gambling and patrons choosing to self-exclude.
