The program will take place at the National Law University (NLU) in New Delhi, India. We project enrollment of seventeen (17) U.S. law students and fifteen (15) Indian law students. All enrollees will reside on the NLU campus. The program begins in December 20, 2011 and ends on January 6, 2012. Students are strongly encouraged to arrive on December 18. There will be holiday breaks the evening of December 23-25 and the evening of December 30-January 2. For more information, see program brochure and go to www.law.unlv.edu/IndiaWinterProgram.html.

Eligibility

Successful completion of all law school courses.

Acceleration

It is unlikely that participation in this program may be used to accelerate graduation. Students interested in acceleration should check with their home schools.

Cancellation Policy

The Boyd School of Law reserves the right, upon notice, to cancel the program. If the U.S. State Department declares New Delhi to be an "Area of Instability" or issues Travel Warnings for New Delhi, India, UNLV policies require the cancellation of the program. If cancellation occurs after the program begins due to the issuance of U.S. State Department Travel Warnings or declaration of New Delhi as an "Area of Instability," students shall receive a full refund of any monies advanced for the program with the exception of room and board costs incurred prior to the cancellation.

All enrollees and applicants will be notified immediately of any cancellation by telephone, mail, and e-mail addresses provided in their applications. Upon notice of cancellation, monies paid by students will be refunded in full. Monies paid by credit card will be refunded within 20 days. The Boyd School of Law will immediately make all available efforts to ensure that any refunds due which have been paid by check or money order will be refunded within 20 days. Reasonable efforts will be made to identify and assist students wishing to enroll in similar programs for U.S. law students in India during the period of this program.

All fees and tuition must be paid no later than December 1, 2011. Students should submit applications prior to November 4 and may apply up to November 4. The last day to withdraw and receive a full refund (not including the \$250 application fee) is November 4, 2011. After November 4, no refunds will be issued, except in the event the program must be cancelled by the sponsors or changes in course offerings or other significant aspects of the program occur.

Credit Transfer

Acceptance of any credit or grade for this course is subject to determination by the enrollee's home school.

Individuals with Disabilities

The program's aim is to treat all participants equally and welcomes applications from people with disabilities. Individuals' needs are taken into account as far as possible, providing reasonable adaptations and assistance within the resources available. We ask that people let us know of any disability or special need (confidentially if required) so that we can help them participate as fully as possible. The facilities are accessible to individuals with disabilities.

Financial Aid

Applicants to the program, who are not students at the Boyd School of Law, should immediately apply through their home universities for financial support.
